

Completing a Non-Producer Status Form

Every buyer is responsible for getting either a **dollar or a document from a seller**. The Non-Producer Status Form is to be used only by someone RESELLING cattle that they have purchased and not held longer than 10 days. This form should go with the cattle when resold. The following spots must be filled out.

- #1. This is the number of cattle being resold. This form can be used for any number of cattle, which are being resold as a group.
- #2. This is the actual date that the cattle are resold.
- #3. Buyer's name/address
- #4. This is the date you, the reseller, initially purchased the cattle.
- #5. This is the reason you are claiming non-producer status.
- #6. Reseller. This is you, the individual reselling the cattle.

What you need to do with the document copies.

- a) The white and yellow copies are given to the buyer, and the pink is for the reseller's/your records.
- b) The buyer is responsible for sending in the white copy to the Wisconsin Beef Council with the monthly remittance form. Those cattle purchased are claimed non-assessed.
